DENTAL PROCEDURES

<u>General Information</u>: The following are recommendations for various dental procedures. Consultation with a knowledgeable hematologist should be obtained before any procedure is performed on a person with a bleeding disorder. Each patient and situation should be assessed on an individual basis.

^{**}Amicar dose is 100 mg/Kg q 6 hours PO not to exceed 6 gms per dose or 24 gms in 24 hours. Avoid the use of antifibrinolytic agents in patients being treated with prothrombin complex concentrates. Amicar mouthwash: may crush tablet and mix with water, use elixir or IV preparation 2.5 mg/10 ml Swish 10 ml over site gently for 2 minutes, repeat QID, then NPO for 1 hour.

Guidelines

- 1. Patients having major dental extractions should be packed with surgical and topical thrombin or the equivalent.
- 2. All patients should avoid hard food (chips, crackers, etc.) for three days to avoid dislodging the fibrin clot.
- 3. Patients should not use a straw.
- 4. Patients with inhibitors require close collaboration with a hemophilia treatment center hematologist.
- 5. Amicar can be used as a mouthwash.
- 6. Side effects of Amicar include nausea, cramping and diarrhea.
