

What is the diagnosis?




Figure 1. Peripheral-Blood Smear Showing Hyperchromic Red Cells Lacking Central Pallor, Howell-Jolly Bodies, and Multiple Intraerythrocytic Ring Forms (Wright-Giemsa Stain).
